Each year, 7,000 young people are lost to sudden cardiac arrest. Our AEDs are easy-to-use automated external defibrillators (AEDs) with voice prompts to walk users through the simple steps necessary in life-saving defibrillation and CPR. Defibrillation within three minutes of sudden cardiac arrest increases the chances of survival to 70 percent.
