Dear Home School Parent,

Information for your annual Home School registration for the 2018-2019 school year is available on our district website [www.forestlake.k12.mn.us](http://www.forestlake.k12.mn.us). From the Forest Lake Area Schools home page click *Student Services*, under it you will find *Homeschool*. These forms include:

**The MDE Full Report** is written information provided to the school, that includes the following information:

- Name, birthdate, grade, address, and contact information of each student.
- Name of primary instructor and secondary instructor (if any).
- Immunization records or a notarized conscientious objection statement.
- Testing Information.

**OR**

**Letter of Intent to continue Homeschooling** is written information provided to the resident school district by October 1 of each year after the instructor has previously provided the same district with a FULL REPORT. It communicates:

- That the family is still homeschooling in the district.
- Changes related to the names and birthdates of the students receiving instruction.
- Changes to the annual nationally normed achievement testing plan
- Changes to the instructor name or qualifications.
- Changes related to the school's accreditation status.
- Update to immunization record – required by law at age 12 (7<sup>th</sup> grade).
  - *(Note that an address change to a new school district requires a full report).*

**Nonpublic Student Aids: (optional)**

The Minnesota Department of Education established the reimbursement rate of \$86.94 for all student's grade K-12, for the 2018-2019 school year. If you choose to participate and in order to be eligible for reimbursement, you are required to complete and return the Student Report for Aids to Nonpublic Students by **October 1, 2018**. All receipts must be dated between July 1, 2018 and June 15, 2019, and turned in to the Forest Lake School District by July 15, 2019. No exceptions.
