## Club Information and Regulations

## Welcome

### Parents:

Southwest Jr. High School Ski Club provides its students with an environment to enjoy affordable downhill skiing and snowboarding in a friendly and fun-filled environment. Join us in keeping it fun and safe for all students .

The ski club only exists as long as we have chaperones. We keep volunteers when we have a club that respects and takes pride in itself. Most of our students only experiment with rails, jumps and moguls. We owe it to them and their parents to run an organization with fair, but strict rules. There will be consequences if the rules are ignored. We need parental help and support in this matter, so please review the information with your student.

### General Information

1. All students must return a Student Agreement Form signed by both the student and a parent, before participation. This serves as a permission slip and medical authorization.
2. It is important that we have contact information in the event of an emergency, list an alternate as well.
3. Payment for Package pricing is due on November 22, 2017. If you are doing the single trips you must pay on the Wednesday before the ski trip. Payment is due prior to going skiing.
4. Check your schedules for conflicts. We cannot offer refunds on Lift Ticket Packages. Should a first week injury prevent a person from using all their package lift tickets we will refund the balance of transportation. No Other Refunds are available.
5. If a student takes the bus up with us they must travel back with us. They Will NOT be allowed to stay behind or leave with someone else. No Exceptions!
6. Trip cancelations will be announced at school or on WCCO should school be canceled. We will make every effort to go on all of our scheduled trips.

## Regulations

Rules specified in the Secondary School Code of Conduct apply to Ski Club activities. Failure to follow these and any rules set forth by Ski Club may result in a loss of privileges with regard to Ski Club.

**Important** Should anyone be found using or involved with the use of **Tobacco, Alcohol, or any other illegal substances**, you will not be allowed to continue with Ski Club Activities. You will be **Removed** from the program. **Stay away from people involved in this.**

## Student ID Tags

1. All club members must have their picture ID's with them to go skiing. If you do not have your ID on Friday see one of the Advisors to receive a temporary ID for the evening. (\$5.00 charge)
2. Duplicate ID's can be issued by Ski Club. Enclose your name and small picture with \$5.00 in a separate envelope marked ID, and put in Club box on Wednesday morning. A new ID will be at bus on Friday.
3. ID's must be **attached** to their jackets to board the bus and must be **worn and visible** at all times. This serves many purposes.
4. If you loose your ID tag at Wild Mountain, report it to an advisor so you can get a temporary for the evening at no charge
5. **If you are found not wearing you ID** or if it is not visible you may **not be allowed to go on the next trip.**

## Lift Tickets

1. Lift tickets must be attached directly to your jacket, such as a zipper or pocket. Do NOT attach with split rings (like on ID tags )
2. You will be removed from Ski Club if you try to sell or give away your lift tickets.
3. You must have your Lift ticket to board the bus when returning to school. Not having it will result in loosing a trip.

## Bus Regulations

1. You must ride to and from Wild Mountain on your assigned bus. The bus list is posted outside the attendance office on Friday .
2. Respectful behavior is expected on the busses at all times. **No food or drink is allowed to be consumed on the bus, No bottles of any kind are allowed on the bus or trip!!!**
3. Busses to Wild Mtn. start loading at 2:10 pm and leave Southwest by 2:30 pm. **ID's are required to board the bus.**
4. Busses back to Southwest start loading at 8:15pm, **ID's and lift tickets required to board bus**, If you are not on the bus by 8:30pm, you will not be going on the next trip. If a problem comes up, notify the advisors prior to the 8:15pm time limit.
5. We **return to Southwest by 9:15 pm.** Please be sure pick up arrangements are made. Pick up is at 9:15. Students not picked up at reasonable times are subject to losing future trips skiing.

## Wild Mountain Regulations

1. Follow directions given by your Chaperones; breaking rules and regulations will result in losing your lift ticket.
2. Renting equipment must be handled at the rental desk,. If you have problems with equipment let them know, or a chaperone.
3. Behave yourself, be respectful of others, no horse play in the chalet, remember to clean up after yourself.
4. Swearing and foul language will not be tolerated. You risk your lift ticket for the night should you have to be reminded.
5. Throwing items or, jumping from the chair lift, spitting, and hollering obscenities will result in losing your skiing privileges.
6. You must ski /board on lit trails, authorized runs only! Stay out of the woods, and do not build jumps.
7. Remember always **Ski/Board in Control** and be aware of others around you.

## Ski Equipment

1. District regulations prohibit the carrying of ski equipment on the regular school busses, it is therefore the responsibility of each student to get their equipment to school.
2. Ski and Snowboard equipment (including boots) are collected on the North side of Southwest in a garage across from the Forest Park II apartments on 7th Ave. SW. We collect materials from 7:00– 7:30 am. The garage is locked at 7:30, it will be unlocked at 2:10 if you missed the earlier collection.
3. All equipment should be stored in ski or board bags labeled with the students name in order that they are not damaged, and to make them identifiable. Unique marking of your bags will make them easier to find both coming and going, we have a lot of students participating and there are many black bags.
4. Before we leave, students can store their backpacks and other items they don't need at Wild Mountain in a locked room. Students will be allowed back into this room at the end of night. Students are **not** allowed to go to their lockers or into the restrooms when we return. **Plan accordingly!**
5. We strongly suggest that students' equipment and belongings be **marked** or labeled in some way. This will discourage theft and provide a means of identification should you need. We get many similar bags and boards, so be sure they are marked inside and out.
6. Every reasonable effort is made to safeguard students belongings. Southwest Ski Club cannot be held responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged equipment or belongings. We recommend the use of Ski Coral at Wild Mtn. for Skis and Boards for only \$1.00 .
7. All bags are subject to search at the discretion of any Ski/Board Club Advisors, school administrators, or liaison officers.

Students with a **Season Pass** to Wild Mountain may deduct the lift ticket portion of any package listed above.
