Snow Spray Paint Fun

Materials:

- small spray bottles
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup of cool water
- 10 drops of food coloring

Directions:

- Pour the water into the spray bottle
- add the food colouring
- repeat for multiple colors/bottles
- spray the snow

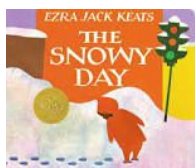


This is a fun activity to strengthen the muscles your child uses to cut and write, and refines your child's pincer grasp.

Extension Activity: Take a walk in the snow and recreate Peter's Day

- walk with your toes pointing out
- walk with your toes pointing in
- drag your feet in the snow to make tracks
- look for a stick to drag behind you to make tracks
- use the stick to knock snow down from a tree
- pick up snow and mold into snowball
- build a snowman
- make snow angels
- pretend to be a mountain climber and look for a pile of snow to climb up and slide down
- make a snowball and put it in your pocket before you go inside
- What do you think will happen to your snowball?

Edible Snowflake Tortillas



Ingredients:

- tortillas
- butter
- white sugar
- cinnamon

Directions:

- warm the tortillas in the microwave for 10 seconds to soften
- melt the butter in the microwave
- fold a tortilla in half, then half again
- with a sanitized scissors, cut the folded tortilla as if you were making a paper snowflake
- open up the tortilla and place on a baking sheet
- brush on melted butter
- sprinkle on sugar and cinnamon
- bake in the oven at 350 for 5 to 10 minutes till desired crispness
- let them cool for a few minutes and ENJOY
